

COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions

BUSINESSES

If I have an employee test positive, what should I do? Have your employee follow the isolation instructions above. They will be contact traced and issued isolation orders. Determine if any other employees were exposed through close contact with the positive case, and the exposed employees need to follow quarantine instructions.

When is it safe for positive or exposed employees to return? Once a positive employee has been released from their isolation, they will be safe to return to work. Exposed employees may return to work after they complete quarantine. Positive employees may still test positive for three months following, so the CDC recommends a symptom based approach rather than a negative test. Please read their recommendation [HERE](#).
